Election Process - 2025

❖ **Important Instructions Regarding the Election:**

1. All candidates and voters must maintain law and order.
2. No individual shall cause any disturbance or violate law and order during the actual voting and counting periods. If found doing so, legal action will be taken against the concerned individuals.
3. It is mandatory for voters to carry their original institutional member ID card when coming to cast their vote.
4. In accordance with the approved rules and regulations of the institution, and as per the election schedule published on date 03/10/2025, voters must follow the guidelines below:
 1. For the Post of President (White Ballot Paper) - 1 Vote
 2. For the Post of Vice-President (Green Ballot Paper) - 4 Votes
 3. For the Post of Honorary Secretary (Blue Ballot Paper) - 1 Vote
 4. For the Post of Managing Committee (Pink Ballot Paper) - 6 Votes
 5. For the Post of Scrutiny Committee Member (Yellow Ballot Paper) - 7 VotesYou are expected to cast your vote by marking 'X' inside the box next to the name of your preferred candidate.
5. If it is found that more than the specified numbers of votes have been cast for any of the above posts, such a ballot paper will be declared invalid. Additionally, any crumpled ballot paper, or any ballot paper containing any writing or signature, will also be declared invalid.
6. The voter must record their vote by placing 'X' mark strictly inside the box next to the name of the candidate they wish to vote for. If the 'X' mark is found outside the box or between two boxes, that ballot paper will be declared invalid, or the Election Officer will hold full authority to make the final decision regarding it.
7. After casting the vote, no individual shall loiter or remain within the polling station premises.
8. The counting process will commence sometime after the voting process is completed. During the counting of votes, the candidates themselves or one representative in writing appointed by them may remain present.
9. Persons with disabilities (Divyangjan) may take the assistance of a family member or another voter to cast their vote. However, that assistant will be permitted to help only one person with a disability.
10. The use of mobile phones or electronic devices, as well as taking photographs or doing videography, is strictly prohibited for candidates, voters, or any ordinary person (except individuals appointed by the Election Officer) inside the polling station and counting centre throughout the entire process. Please note that if anyone is found doing so, legal action will be taken against them.
11. All the above instructions must be strictly followed, and full cooperation must be extended to all the staff on election duty.
12. The said voting and counting processes are being conducted in accordance with the orders dated 13.03.2026 of the Hon'ble Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, the approved rules and regulations of the trust, and the election schedule announced on date 03/10/2025. All candidates and voters must note that the decision of the Election Officer shall be final. This is a request.
